Responsibilities:

- Familiarize yourself with the biosphere's mission, vision, and projects
- Communicate with the public about tide times, the ecology and geology of the St. Martins' Sea Caves
- Assist in public engagement events and projects within the biosphere where applicable

- Knowledge of the Fundy Biosphere Region (Upper Bay of Fundy), the Bay of Fundy's tides, and the natural environment
- Experience communicating with the public
- Experience working in a team and within a remote setting and/or outside

- Ability to work with others and as well as independently
- Physically able to walk on rocky shores and throughout the Village of St Martins
